



UQRDM Thesis Submission

UQ Research Data Manager (UQRDM) is UQ's recommended place to store all active research data. HDR students will now be able to submit their thesis through UQRDM. After submission, students will be able to follow the progress of their thesis through their Thesis Dashboard at rdm.uq.edu.au.



What you need for initial submission

- » UQRDM record
- » Thesis
- » iThenticate report
- » Supplementary files (if applicable)

What you need for final submission

- » Thesis
- » Abstract
- » Supplementary files (if applicable)

About UQRDM

UQRDM is a world leading data management system designed and developed at the University of Queensland. It allows all UQ researchers to store and share their data safely and securely while meeting data storage requirement for UQ and national policies & guidelines. UQRDM currently has over 12,000 unique active users from around the world.



Create an **UQRDM record** for your research data, mark it as a HDR project and nominate your principal advisor as the Lead Investigator. You will gain access to the Thesis Dashboard shortly after you complete your final milestone.

1. BEFORE SUBMISSION



Submit your thesis, your iThenticate report and supplementary files (if applicable) through the submission form on your Thesis Dashboard. Follow the progression of your thesis step-by-step on your Thesis Dashboard in **UQRDM**.

2. INITIAL SUBMISSION

3. AFTER SUBMISSION

Your submission will then go to your principal advisor and the Graduate School who will approve submission or request amendments. The Graduate School will then send your thesis to your examiners.



4. FINAL SUBMISSION

Once your thesis goes through the examination process and is marked as passed, you will be asked to submit the final version of your thesis. After conferral, your thesis will be sent to UQ eSpace.
